## **BORGESON-WICKMAN**

**Charles Bernhard Borgeson** and his wife **Mathilda Ulrica Wickman** lived in Baychester in the 1940s at **2198 Palmer Avenue**, a corner house with a large lot right next to the railroad tracks.<sup>1</sup>

**Charles Bernhard Borgeson** was born on December 16, 1870 in Gothenburg, Sweden, the son of **Alexander and Anna Rose Borgeson**.<sup>2</sup> He immigrated around 1892 and lived in The Bronx until his death. On October 9, 1897, Charles and Mathilda married in Manhattan, New York.<sup>3</sup>

**Mathilda Ulrica Wickman** was born on March 15, 1879 in Vaasa, Sweden; her parents have not yet been identified. She immigrated to Ellis Island, New York from Liverpool, England on May 30, 1895, a 17-year-old young lady working as a servant, and married two years later. 4

Charles and Mathilda Borgeson had three children: Charles Arthur Borgeson (1898-1972), Agnes M. Borgeson (1900-1992), and Mildred Alice Borgeson (1905 - ????). Charles supported his family as a carpenter for the railroad, and raised his family in The Bronx.<sup>5</sup>

By 1940, the children all out of the household, Charles and Mathilda moved into Baychester and lived at **2198 Palmer Avenue**. Son Charles Arthur Borgeson married and eventually moved to Florida. Daughter Agnes Borgeson married Louis Wagner and moved to Queens. Daughter Mildred Borgeson married George Schmitt and also moved to Queens.

Charles died on February 16, 1947 in The Bronx.<sup>2</sup> He is buried in Nassau Knolls Memorial Park in Port Washington, New York.<sup>6</sup>

After her husband's death, Mathilda Borgeson moved in with her daughter Agnes and son-in-law Louis Wagner in Queens<sup>7</sup>.
