DeHAYES-HEAGENEY-BARMORE-BRAZ-ERD

Louis Peter DeHayes and **Ellen Heageney** married about 1894, probably in Manhattan, New York, where they resided until new houses on Boller Avenue were built. By 1930 they were living at **2325 Boller Avenue**, Baychester, Bronx, New York. ¹

During their stay in Manhattan, Louis DeHayes worked as a metal spinner in a lamp shop² to support his family. He and Ellen raised six children in Manhattan, New York. When he moved to Baychester he became a Watchman at a dynamite factory. The Ditmars Dynamite factory was located in Baychester, and it was probably where Louis worked.

Louis Peter DeHayes was born in 1873 in New York City, New York, the son of Belgian native **Achille Thomas DeHayes** and his wife, New York City native **Julia May Grevenig**.³ He was the first of seven children born to Achille and Julia, and was raised in Manhattan. It is not known when he died or where he is buried.

Ellen Heageney was born in 1873 in New York City, New York, the daughter of Irish immigrants **John Heageney** and **Mary Renehan**. She was raised in Manhattan, New York, and had at least two other siblings, **Terrance Joseph Heageney**⁴ and **Cecelia Heageney**⁵. Cecelia and her widowed father lived with her younger sister and brother-in law, Ellen and Louis, in 1900.

Ellen died on May 4, 1933 in the Bronx, New York at the age of 60. Her husband Louis was still living. She is buried at Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Hawthorne, Westchester County, New York.⁶

In 1930, three of their six children still lived with them when they moved to Baychester. Their son John, age 26; daughter Ellen, age 21; and married daughter Gladys, age 33 along with Gladys' husband and Gladys' two children. So that made for a full house.¹

The following three children lived in Baychester.

Daughter **Gladys DeHayes** was born Oct 18, 1896 in New York City, New York⁷ and lived with her parents in Manhattan. Gladys married **Steven Leroy Barmore** about 1915, probably in Manhattan. Gladys and Steven lived with her parents in Manhattan and Baychester¹, Bronx until some time between 1931-1935, when Steven Barmore moved his wife and children to a house in Queens, New York. Gladys and Steven Barmore had three children: Steven Jr. (born 1916); Arthur (born 1919); and Gladys (born 1922). Steven Barmore Sr. is deceased, date unknown. Gladys (DeHayes) Barmore died March 1988, living in Queens at the time.⁸ All three children are deceased, dates unknown. Any burial locations are all unknown.

Son **John Charles DeHayes** was born in 1903 in New York City, New York and lived with his parents¹ until his marriage to **Margaret** around 1931. After his marriage, John and Margaret moved out of Baychester to another home elsewhere in the Bronx. He and Margaret (maiden name unknown) raised two children. He was a New York City Fireman.⁹ It is unknown when he died or where he is buried. His wife, Margaret, died May 8, 1988 in the Bronx, New York.¹⁰ It is unknown where she is buried.

Daughter **Ellen Catherine DeHayes** was born July 29, 1908 in Manhattan, New York, ¹¹ and lived with her parents while growing up in Manhattan and Baychester, Bronx, New York and after

marrying **Samuel Braz** (or Stuart Braz, depending on source) in the early 1930s. The author's cousins remember the Braz family in the 1950s-1960s still living in Baychester. Ellen and Samuel raised two children in Baychester. ¹² It is unknown when Samuel and Ellen (DeHayes) died or where they are buried. One child, daughter **Patricia Braz** married **Edward Joseph Erd** in 1964 in Manhattan, New York¹³. Patricia was born on November 1, 1937 in New York, and died March 17, 1999 in South Carolina¹⁴. Her husband Edward Erd, a native Bronxite, was born September 29, 1932 in New York City, New York and died December 2, 2016 in South Carolina; he is buried at Ascension Cemetery, Monsey, Rockland County, New York¹⁵. Patricia and Edward Erd had a daughter, **Ellen Marie Erd**, born May 4, 1972, and died September 19, 2010 in South Carolina¹⁶. It is unknown where Ellen Marie Erd or her mother Patricia (Braz) Erd are buried.

The following three children never lived in Baychester:

Louis Augustus Dehayes (1895-1947); Julia Dehayes (1899-???); and Achille DeHayes who died in infancy at 10 months old (November 18, 1905 – September 14, 1906), and was buried in Calvary Cemetery, Woodside, Queens, New York.¹⁷
