DEUTSCH

Phillip Deutsch and his wife Elsie lived in Baychester in 1930 at **2331 Boller Avenue**. This was down the street from where **Joseph Huber** and **Louisa Deutsch** live, at 2230 Boller Avenue. Elsie's maiden name is unknown. Phillip owned this house.

Phillip Deutsch was born in 1871 in New York, son of Hungarian immigrants **Leopold Deutsch** and **Rosa Berg**. His first wife was Jeanette Greenfield, with whom he had two children. They did not live in Baychester. His second wife was Elsie, with whom he did live in Baychester. Elsie was born in Germany, and immigrated in 1925. They married sometime between 1925-1930.

Phillip worked as an Accountant in the insurance industry, and later as an Accountant for the steam railway. His last job was as a Ticket Agent for the I.R.T. Subway.

At the time of Phillip's death on December 27, 1935³ he was living on East Tremont Avenue in the Bronx. He was laid to rest at Fresh Pond Crematory and Columbarium, Middle Village, Queens, New York City, New York, United States.

After his death in 1935, Elsie moved out of the Bronx and into Queens, New York, where she worked as a housekeeper for George Metz, starting in 1935. What happened to Elsie after 1940 is unknown.
