## **FREVERT**

**Andrew and Florence Frevert** rented an apartment in a house at 2222 Boller Avenue, Baychester, Bronx, New York in 1940.<sup>1</sup>

**Andrew W. Frevert** was born in the Bronx on July 27, 1908.<sup>2</sup> His parents were **Andrew J. Frevert** and **Caroline Josephine Kleman**, both born in New York City. He was the first of three children. Andrew grew up in the Bronx.

In 1910 Andrew lived with his parents at 2037 Belmont Avenue, the heart of the Bronx's "Little Italy", where his father, of Russian ancestry, supported the family as a concrete mason<sup>3</sup>. By 1920 Andrew had a little brother Phillip and a little sister Caroline; he lived with his parents and siblings at Park Avenue in the Bronx, next door to his maternal Kleman grandparents, who were of German ancestry<sup>4</sup>. His brother Philip died in 1920<sup>5</sup> and was buried in Saint Raymond's Cemetery, Bronx, New York<sup>6</sup>.

By 1930 Andrew's parents along with Andrew and his sister Caroline had moved again and were renting an apartment at 1109 Findlay Avenue; Andrew was age 21 and working as a radio mechanic<sup>7</sup>.

Between 1930-1935 Andrew W. Frevert married Florence (maiden name unknown). In 1935 Andrew and Florence rented an apartment at 2222 Boller Avenue. They were in the same house in 1940, along with their daughter Lois. Andrew supported the family as a radio repairman.<sup>8</sup> Perhaps part of their fun time was spent on the water, a mere one block from their

At some point Andrew moved to the New Jersey shore. He died on May 26, 1957<sup>2</sup> at age 49, and was buried in Saint Catherine's Cemetery in Sea Girt, Monmouth County, New Jersey.9

Florence C. (---) Frevert was born on November 27, 1906, maiden name unknown. She died in October 1984<sup>10</sup> in Monmouth County, New Jersey at age 78, 27 years after Andrew, and was buried with Andrew. 11

The status of their daughter Lois is unknown in 2018.
