

HALAISKI-CLEVELAND

Adolph Charles Halaiski and his wife **Helen Gertrude (Cleveland) Halaiski** lived in Baychester at **2224 Boller Avenue**.¹

Adolph C. Halaiski was born Jan. 31, 1914 in Manhattan, New York², the second of two children of Poland immigrants **Charles Joseph Halaiski** and **Paulina Olaganieska**. He lived in the Bronx in the 1920s³, and then the family moved back to Manhattan where he met his wife. **Helen Gertrude Cleveland** was born Oct. 9, 1914 in Manhattan, New York⁴, daughter of native New Yorkers **Walter L. Cleveland** and **Isabella M. Plass**.⁵ Adolph and Helen married on August 26, 1936 in Manhattan, New York.⁶

By 1942 Adolph and Helen were living at 2224 Boller Avenue in the Bronx, New York.² They had a son, **Ralph G. Halaiski**. Ralph was born on January 13, 1945 in Manhattan, New York.⁴ Adolph was supporting his family as a Senior Clerk in the Railroad Transport industry.¹

At some point the family moved out of Baychester but remained in The Bronx, New York.

Adolph Charles Halaiski died at age 54 in May 1968.⁷ His wife **Helen Gertrude Halaiski** died in New York at age 78 on February 20, 1993.⁸ It is not known where either might be buried.

Their son, **Ralph Girard Halaiski** served in the US Navy for 2 years from 1965-1967 in Vietnam. He died at age 60 on October 6, 2005 and is buried at Calverton National Cemetery, Calverton, Suffolk County, New York.⁹

Adolph and Helen had a second child, **Helen Mary Halaiski**, born April 10, 1951 in Manhattan, NY.⁴ She married **Herbert John Evans** in 1971 and they moved out of Baychester.
