HLAWITSCHKA-BENDER

In the late 1930s through 1940s **Anton Hlawitschka** and his wife **Frieda Bender** lived in Baychester, Bronx, New York at **2301 Boller Avenue**¹, a corner house intersecting Stillwell Avenue. Anton bought this house when it was less than 10 years old. He and Frieda raised two boys here. Anton worked as a linotype operator for a German newspaper to support his family.

Anton's sister Emma (Hlawitschka) Petricek and her family also lived in Baychester in the 1930s just a few houses down at 2327 Boller Avenue.² His sister Hilda (Hlawitschka) Schobert lived one block away at 2314 Palmer Avenue. His sister Marie (Hlawitschka) Schnable also lived across the street at 2324 Boller Avenue. All four siblings lived in Baychester for many years.

Anton Hlawitschka was born on March 30, 1894 in Vienna, Austria, son of Austrian citizens Anton Hlawischka and Emma Reinelt³. Anton immigrated to America, settling in Manhattan, New York City, New York in 1922, as many immigrants did. His soon-to-be-wife Frieda Bender was born on August 10, 1903 in Frankfurt, Germany, daughter of German citizens Friederick Bender and Maria Wanninger³. Frieda immigrated to America in 1923 at age 20 along with her sister Rose Bender, age 18. They were going to live with her aunt, Mrs. Charles Sittig, at 2152 Webster Avenue, Belmont, Bronx, New York⁴.

Frieda and Anton married on September 6, 1927 in Manhattan, New York City, New York³. In 1942 they were still living in Baychester, Anton still working for a German newspaper published by the Staats-Herald Corporation.⁵

Anton died in Tilson, Ulster, New York in April 1967⁶. Fifteen years later Frieda died in the Bronx, New York in March 1982⁷. Burial information is unknown.

Their first-born child, a son also named **Anton Hlawitschka**, was born February 21, 1929 in New York City, New York. He grew up in Baychester. He married **Dorothy Behr** in 1957 in the Bronx, New York. Dorothy was born on September 3, 1935.

In the mid-1960s Anton and his wife Dotty were avid bowlers in leagues in Yonkers, New York.⁸ By 1989 he and his family were living in Florida, where he died on May 29, 1996. His burial information is unknown.⁹

A second son, **Walter Hlawitschka**, was born on August 21, 1933 in New York City, New York and also grew up in Baychester. He married **Arlene Gluck** in 1954 in the Bronx, New York. After marriage the couple moved to Long Island, New York. Arlene was born on March 28, 1936 in The Bronx, New York. She died November 30, 2019 and was buried in Commack Cemetery, Commack, Huntington, Suffolk, New York. Walter died in the following year in 2020 and was buried alongside his wife in the same cemetery.
