## **JOHANSEN**

**Alfred Johansen** immigrated from Svendborg, Denmark. His date of immigration is around 1890. He was born **Frederik Vilhelm Alfred Johannessen** on July 20, 1873 of Danish parents **Fritz Johansen** and **Doris Cathrine Henriette Kock**. There are many alternate spellings.

Alfred was the third of four children. He is in the 1880 Denmark census with his parents and siblings<sup>2</sup>. He was Confirmed in Denmark at St. Nicholas Church in Svendborg, Denmark on April 15, 1888<sup>3</sup>. Upon immigration he settled in New York City, New York,

Alfred married **Minnie** (maiden name unknown) perhaps around 1900, as their first child **Charles** was born around 1901; their second child **Elsie** (or Elizabeth) was born around 1903. This family stayed hidden from census enumerators until 1920, when they were enumerated twice, 3 weeks apart, at two different addresses but in the same neighborhood, Baychester, Bronx, New York. On January 7, 1920 Alfred and Minnie resided on Baychester Avenue<sup>4</sup> (no number); on January 20, 1920 they resided on Boller Avenue (no number). In both censuses their two children are living with them. Alfred supported his family as a patrolman for the police department, patrolling a private building.<sup>5</sup>

Alfred died on November 2, 1923 in the Bronx, New York. He was 50 years old, and was working as a Watchman<sup>6</sup>. He was buried in Lutheran Cemetery, unknown location. No record is found of his wife **Minnie Johansen** after this, nor his two children. They just disappeared.
