

# KEARNEY-SAVARESE-LAUB

**Ignatius Kearney** was born August 1, 1904 in Queens, New York, son of native New Yorkers **Charles Kearney** and **Mary Ellen Lyons**<sup>1</sup>. In 1920 he was living in Manhattan<sup>2</sup>, but by 1930 he and his bride were living in Baychester, Bronx, New York.

Ignatius Kearney, aka **Ignatius T. Homer Kearney**, married **Theresa Augusta Savarese** around 1928 when he was 23 and she was 21. Theresa Savarese was born January 13, 1907 in Manhattan, New York, the first of six children of **Anthony Savarese**, of Egypt, and **Ella Reed**, of Brooklyn, New York<sup>3</sup> (see biography SAVARESE-REED.)

Theresa grew up in Baychester, and after marriage the couple stayed in Baychester and rented a cute little house at **2202 Palmer Avenue**. Ignatius supported his family as a marble polisher.**Error! Bookmark not defined.** They had one child, **Charlotte Kearney**, who was born on June 1, 1931 in Manhattan, New York.

Through 1940<sup>4</sup> and until his death in 1942, Ignatius and his family resided at that house in Baychester. **Ignatius Kearney** died at the young age of 37 on April 19, 1942<sup>5</sup> in the Bronx, New York. He is buried at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Hawthorne, Westchester County, New York.<sup>6</sup>

## KEARNEY-SAVARESE-LAUB

After the death of Ignatius Kearney, Theresa was married again to **Karl Laub** on July 30, 1947 in the Bronx, New York.<sup>7</sup> Karl, Theresa, and child Charlotte Kearney Laub moved to a different house in Baychester at **2232 Boller Avenue**.<sup>8</sup>

Karl and Theresa Laub eventually moved to St. Lucie, Florida. **Karl Laub**, who was born on October 24, 1900 in Germany, died in 1990 in Florida and was buried at All Saints Cemetery, Jensen Beach, Martin County, Florida.<sup>9</sup> **Theresa Laub** died 14 years later on February 1, 2004 and was buried next to her second husband, Karl Laub.<sup>10</sup>

**Charlotte Kearney Laub Muller** died on December 22, 2008 in Torrance, Los Angeles County, California.
