KRUEGER-CONROY

Walter Robert Krueger and **Lillian Dolores Conroy** lived at 2230 Palmer Avenue in 1950 in Baychester, Bronx, New York.¹

Walter R. Krueger was the son of Paul Krueger and Ida Millman (see biography for KRUEGER-MUEHLEMAN) and lived most of his life in various houses in Baychester. He was born on June 5, 1914 in the Bronx, New York² and lived on Waterbury Avenue. The family then moved to Glover Street, still in the Bronx. By 1925 the family lived on St. Raymond Avenue.³ By 1930 there were some new houses in Baychester, and they owned and lived at 2310 Palmer Avenue.⁴

Lillian D. Conroy was born in New York City on August 26, 1913, daughter of **William Conroy** and **Margaret Kelley**. She was the third of five children, and grew up in Manhattan, New York.

Walter Krueger and **Lillian Conroy** were married in New Jersey in 1932. In 1935 the couple was living in rural New York City, and by 1940 they were living Ulster, New York⁵. **Walter Krueger** was then working as a mine driller.

By 1950 **Walter and Lillian** moved back into Baychester, building a new house at **2230 Palmer Avenue**. This house was next to the small hill covering the Dittmar dynamite bunker at the corner of Palmer and Stillwell Avenues. Walter was now the Blasting Inspector for the New York City Fire Department. They had three children: **Walter R. Krueger, Lawrence M. Krueger**, and **Karen Krueger**. The family lived in that house through at least the 1960's.

Walter R. Krueger died in Baychester on January 23, 1968.⁶ He is buried in Gate of Heaven Cemetery⁷ in Hawthorne, Westchester County, New York. **Lillian Krueger** died on March 23, 2003 in Andover, Massachusetts⁸; she is buried with her husband in Gate of Heaven Cemetery⁹, Hawthorne, Westchester County, New York.

Son Walter R. Krueger, Jr. changed his name to William Paul Krueger. In 1974 he married Susan Caton Cline in Florida. Son Lawrence Krueger – no further information on him. Daughter Karen Krueger married Steven Altman in 1971 in Brooklyn, New York.
