KRUEGER-JACOBS

Herman Krueger and **Johanna Jacobs** lived in Baychester, Bronx, New York. Although they were married around 1878, they are not found in the 1880 census. They did not have any children.¹

Herman Krueger was born in November 1857 in Germany. He immigrated to New York in 1877, about one year before he married Johanna. **Johanna Jacobs** was born January 1854 in Germany, daughter of Germans **Ludwig Jacobs** and **Kassline Pfeffer**. She immigrated to New York in 1877 also.

Herman Krueger was a saloon keeper. In 1900 he and his wife lived in a house without a number on Baychester Avenue. They lived next door to the owner of the neighborhood bar, John Stark¹. By 1910 they had moved to a house on Wright Avenue². Unfortunately, Herman died on February 10, 1911 in the Bronx, New York. He was buried at Fresh Pond, Long Island, Queens, New York.³

Johanna eventually moved to a house she owned at **2210 Boller Avenue**⁴, where we find her in 1925, and where she stayed until her death on December 21, 1941. She was buried at Fern Cliff Crematorium in Westchester County, New York⁵, 30 years after her husband had died.

There were several Kruegers living in Baychester over the decades. There was probably a relationship between them and Herman Krueger.
