Paul Carl Krueger and his wife **Ida Theresa Muehleman** lived in Baychester in a house they owned at **2310 Palmer Avenue** since before 1930. They had a large family – seven children, but not all of those children lived in Baychester.

Paul Carl Krueger was born on January 8, 1880 in Binghamton, Broome County, New York, son of German immigrants **Max Krueger** and **Carolina Rothenstein**. Paul was the fifth of nine children. He was the only person in his family that moved to the Bronx, New York; the rest of his siblings resided in Brooklyn and Queens, New York.

Ida Theresa Muehleman/Millmann was born on March 19, 1881 in Manhattan, New York, daughter of Swiss immigrants **Nikolaus Muehlemann** and **Charlotte Foster**.² She was the last of nine children, and she grew up in New York City.

Paul and Ida married in Manhattan, New York on November 23, 1900, a week before Thanksgiving.³ From 1901 through 1927 they had seven children. Paul started out working as a bartender at the tender young age of 20⁴, when he met his future wife Ida. After marriage, he became a driver for the Ditmars dynamite company⁵, and eventually he was foreman and detonator of high explosives.

By the time he bought his own house in Baychester, Bronx, New York in 1930 he had become a Fire Inspector for the New York City Fire Department.⁶ By 1940 he was a Blasting Inspector. He

retired as a Fire Inspector. He died on December 25, 1948 in Queens, New York at age 68, and was buried at Mount Hope Cemetery in Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester County, New York. 8

Paul had served as a Sargeant in the US Army during the Spanish American War in 1898 in Cuba.⁹

Ida, his wife, continued to live in their house in Baychester until her death on June 18, 1964. She was 83 years old when she died, 15 years after her husband. She is buried with Paul in Mount Hope Cemetery. 10

1. Marea Ida Krueger was born on September 10, 1901¹¹ in Manhattan, New York, and married **Thomas Mannello** in 1921.¹² They had four children. They lived in the Bronx, New York, but not in Baychester.¹³ Marea Mannello died on January 13, 1990, and is buried in Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Hawthorne, New York.¹⁴ Her husband Thomas Mannello was born on January 6, 1900 in New York and died in March of 1969. He is also buried in Gate of Heaven Cemetery.¹⁵

- **2. Arthur Edward Krueger** was born on March 7, 1903 in Manhattan, New York, ¹⁶ and married **Mary "Mae" Cannon** on June 3, 1925 in New York City, New York. ¹⁷ They had one child, **Arthur Edward Krueger**, **Jr.** (1926-1992). ¹⁸ They lived in the Bronx, New York, but not in Baychester, then moved to Queens ¹⁹, and then to Nassau County, New York. Arthur Sr. died on December 7, 1987 in Hicksville, Nassau, New York ²⁰ and is buried in Cemetery of the Holy Rood in Westbury, Nassau, New York. ²¹ His wife Mae was born on February 23, 1905 in Queens, New York, died on January 12, 1987 in New York, just 11 months prior to her husband's death, and is buried in the same cemetery. ²²
- **3. Paul Carl Krueger, Jr.** was born on April 5, 1907 in the Bronx, New York²³ and married **Josephine Harriett O'Brien** on August 17, 1928 in New York City, New York. They had one child, **Paul Carl Krueger III** (1930-2010). They lived in the Bronx, New York,²⁴ but not in Baychester, then moved to Putnam County, New York.²⁵ (See Krueger-O'Brien biography)

Paul Jr. enlisted in the US Army in 1942 and served as a Civil Engineer.²⁶ He died on June 3, 1973 and is buried in Long Island National Cemetery in East Farmingdale, Suffolk County, New York.²⁷ His wife Josephine was born October 29, 1904 in Manhattan, New York.²⁸ She lived in the Bronx²⁹ most of her life until 1940 where she and Paul were living in Putnam County. Josephine died on January 28, 1991, 18 years after her husband. She is buried with him in Long Island National Cemetery.³⁰

4. *Elsie Reynolds Krueger was born on February 11, 1909 in the Bronx, New York.³¹ She married, first, **Robert Jacob Lachmann**, on November 7, 1930 in the Bronx, New York.³² Robert moved into the house Elsie was living in with her parents, Paul and Ida Krueger, at **2310 Palmer Avenue**. ³³ Elsie and Robert had three children while living with her parents.³⁴ Robert Lachmann was born on December 9, 1902 in Manhattan, New York³⁵, and died on September 3, 1943³² in Burlington County, New Jersey. It is unknown where he is buried.

Elsie married, second, **Osmer William Leavy**, with whom she had two more children. They lived on City Island, New York City, New York. Elsie Reynolds (Krueger) Leavy died on September 16, 1968 at age 51 in the Bronx, New York. She was buried in Mount Hope Cemetery, Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester, New York. Osmer William Leavy was born in 1904 and died in 1992. Nothing else is known about him.³²

- **5. *Walter Robert Krueger** was born on June 5, 1914 in the Bronx, New York. ³⁶ He lived in Baychester at **2310 Palmer Avenue** with his parents in the 1930s. ³⁷ In about 1932 Walter married **Lillian Delores Conroy** and they had two children. They were living in Ulster, New York by 1940, when he supported his family as a mine driller. ³⁸ Walter died on January 23, 1968 in Baychester, Bronx, New York, and was buried in Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Hawthorne, Westchester, New York. ³⁹ His wife Lillian Delores Conroy was born on August 23, 1913 in Manhattan, New York. She died on March 23, 2003, 35 years after her husband, and was buried with him in Gate of Heaven Cemetery. ⁴⁰ (See Krueger-Conroy biography)
- **6. *Grace Krueger** was born on July 24, 1921 in New York. ⁴¹ She grew up in Baychester at **2310 Palmer Avenue**, ³⁷ and after marrying **Ralph Savarese** in the mid-1940's they hand-built a house in the neighborhood on the next block on Boller Avenue. (See Savarese-Krueger biography)
- **7.*William James Krueger** was born on March 12, 1927 in New York.⁴² He grew up in Baychester at **2310 Palmer Avenue** and lived there until he died. On May 28, 1949 he married **Charlotte Hertha Schobert**.⁴³ William died in Baychester on March 15, 2000, and was buried in
