

LYNAR

Almost nothing is known about the **Lynar family** that lived at **2204 Palmer Avenue** in 1940.¹

John Lynar was born about 1893 in New York. His wife, **Lily Lynar** (maiden name unknown) was also born about 1893 in New York. They married about 1923, probably in Manhattan, New York, and settled in the Bronx, New York.

They had a daughter, **Harriet Lynar**, born about 1925 in New York. By 1940 they were renting a house in Baychester at **2204 Palmer Avenue**. A niece, **Evelyn Kelly**, also born about 1925, was living with the Lynar family in Baychester in 1940. John supported his family working as a Highwayman for the NY Highway Department.

It has been a futile effort to discover anything else about this family with confidence.
