**Michael Mauderer** and his wife **Margaret Uhl** lived on a boathouse off **Baychester Avenue** in Baychester, Bronx, NY in the early 1900s.<sup>1</sup>

**Michael Mauderer** was born in Germany on February 21, 1856. He immigrated to America in 1880. His wife, **Margaret Uhl** was born in Germany in February 1857. She also immigrated to America in 1880.<sup>1</sup> Since their first child was born in Germany in 1879 and they did not immigrate until 1880, they were probably married in Germany. No immigration records have been found.

Michael and Margaret had six children – one in Germany, and five in Manhattan, New York. The first three children lived to adulthood; the second three children died in infancy. It is not known how Michael supported his large family in the early years while they lived in Manhattan. They are finally found in 1900 in Baychester with Michael owning and living on a boat house, located at Baychester Avenue which, at that time, was by Given's Creek. He was renting boats. Living with Michael was his wife and three adult children.<sup>1</sup> By 1910 Michael had moved to a corner house at **2223 Wright Avenue**, also along the creek, with his wife and son **Robert**. Michael and son Robert were still building and renting boats from the boat house.<sup>2</sup> Michael died in 1925 at age 69, and was buried in Old Saint Raymonds Cemetery in the Bronx, New York.<sup>3</sup>

After Michael's death, his wife Margaret remained in the house at 2223 Wright Avenue<sup>4</sup> until her death on April 4, 1937.<sup>5</sup> She was buried with her husband at Old Saint Raymonds Cemetery.<sup>6</sup>

## THEIR CHILDREN

**Robert Mauderer** was born in Germany in March 1879 and immigrated to New York with his parents around 1880.<sup>1</sup> He lived in Baychester with his parents until his death at age 33 on

January 8, 1912,<sup>7</sup> and was buried in Old Saint Raymonds Cemetery in the Bronx, New York.<sup>8</sup> He worked as a boatman, and never married.

**Henry Mauderer** was born on June 1, 1885 in Manhattan, New York.<sup>9</sup> He lived in Baychester in 1900, but by 1910 he lived elsewhere. On July 20, 1912 Henry married **Marina Muse** in the Bronx, New York.<sup>10</sup> **Marina Muse** was born in 1893 in New York, daughter of New Jersey native **Cornelius Muse** and German immigrant **Annie Brockman**. They had two children: **Cornelius Mauderer**, born in 1913; and **Henrietta Mauderer**, born in 1917. He was supporting his family as a New York City Patrolman.<sup>11</sup> Daughter Henrietta died at age 11 on February 21, 1928, and is buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, Bronx, New York.<sup>12</sup> By the 1930 census, Marina is a married head of household with her son Cornelius and mother living with her;<sup>13</sup> no sign of husband Henry. Henry is not found again until his death on March 16, 1963 in El Paso, Texas.<sup>14</sup> The informant on his death certificate is "Mrs. Henry Mauderer" so we do not know her name. Henry is buried in Fort Bliss National Cemetery in El Paso, Texas. He served as a CPL in US Army Coast Artillery Corps.<sup>15</sup> It is unknown when his wife Marina died or where she might be buried.

**Magdalena Mauderer** was born in May 1887 in New York. She married **Arthur Stuart Henderson** on March 28, 1907 in the Bronx, New York. The biography of Arthur Stuart Henderson and Magdalena Mauderer is found in a separate listing.

**Jennie Mauderer** was born and died on July 3, 1890 in Manhattan, New York. She is buried in Saint Raymonds Cemetery, Bronx, New York.<sup>16</sup>

**Katharina Mauderer** was born July 20, 1893 in Manhattan.<sup>17</sup> She died on January 10, 1894 at age 5-1/2 months.<sup>18</sup> Her burial location is unknown.

**Dora Mauderer** was born March 9, 1895 in Manhattan.<sup>19</sup> She died on August 11, 1895 at age 5 months.<sup>20</sup> Her burial location is unknown.
