Henry Meyer and Gertrude (Grotz) Meyer rented a house at 2195 Palmer Avenue, Baychester, Bronx, New York from the mid-1930s to at least 1940. Gertrude's brother Harold Grotz lived across the street at 2200 Palmer Avenue in 1930, and by 1935 had moved to 2205 Palmer Avenue¹ (see biography GROTZ-RIVETTI.)

Henry Meyer was born in New York in 1898, son of **Edward** (born in Germany) and **Amelia** (born in France) **Meyer.** He served in the World War (WW I)². Henry married **Gertrude Grotz** on September 22, 1929 in Manhattan, New York.³ Henry supported his family as an auto mechanic.

Henry and Gertrude had a son, **Walter Meyer**, who died as a child. He was born in 1931, and died on August 11, 1935 in the Bronx, New York. At the time of death he was living at 2195 Palmer Avenue, Baychester, Bronx, NY. They buried their 4-year-old baby boy at Mt. Hope Cemetery in New York.⁴

Henry and Gertrude had another child, daughter **Barbara Meyer**, born in early 1941 in New York.⁵

Henry Meyer died a few years after his son Walter, on July 28, 1940, in the Bronx. He is also buried at Mt. Hope Cemetery, New York.⁶

MEYER-GROTZ

Gertrude (Grotz) Meyer was born in April 11, 1904 in New York City, daughter of **August Grotz and Millie Beasterci**. Her father, August, emigrated from Germany. Her mother, Millie, was born in New York, the daughter of Hungarian and Czeckoslovakian parents. Gertrude was the first of four children, only two of which lived to adulthood.

Gertrude grew up in various apartment houses in Manhattan, New York. After marriage, Gertrude and Henry Meyer moved to the Bronx and lived in Baychester. At some time after the 1950 census, Gertrude sold her Baychester house to the Iron and Steel Factory that abutted her property; she then purchased a small house at 782 Mill Plain RD, Fairfield, Fairfield, Connecticut. Gertrude Meyer died on August 4, 1984 in Bridgetown, Fairfield, Connecticut. It is unknown where she is buried.⁸

No additional information is known about daughter Barbara Meyer.
