Mrs. Helen F. O'Neill [maiden name unknown] was born in New York between 1877-1881. Since she changed her age from census to census, and no birth record has been found, her age cannot be accurately determined at this time. Her parents were from Ireland.

Helen O'Neill lived in Baychester from the early 1920's through the 1930's. She owned her house at **2321 Palmer Avenue**. Helen was on the 1924 Voter Registration list, the 1925 New York State census¹, and the 1930 Federal census². She was a widow since at least 1925.

Helen probably lived at 2321 Palmer Avenue until the city took the house in the late 1930's for the Bruckner Expressway exit ramp, and entrance into Baychester.

No information has been uncovered as to her husband, or if she had any children. No information has been discovered on where she may have moved to after the 1930's, or when or where she died or may be buried.
