PASARELLI

From at least 1935-1942 **Salvatore Pasarelli** lived in Baychester at **2239 Boller Avenue**.¹ He was born about 1896 in Italy. In 1940 he stated he was married, but his wife was not living with him. At that time he was working as a chicken raiser in the poultry industry. I wonder if he raised them on Boller Avenue, or had a different facility for raising the chickens. Salvatore was naturalized by 1940, but his papers have not been found, not has his immigration records.

No other information has been found for Salvatore Pasarelli.
