PRAZSKY-NESPOR

William Prazsky and his wife **Antonia Nespor** lived in Baychester, Bronx, New York for a short while at 2213 Hunter Avenue.

William Prazsky was born on November 28, 1892 in Hrabjesy, Bohemia, Czechoslovakia¹, son of Bohemian parents **Anton Prazsky** and **Frances Iova**². When he was 13 years old he immigrated in 1905 and resided in Manhattan³.

William married **Antonia Nespor** on May 2, 1914 in Manhattan, New York. He was 22 years old; she was 24 years old.² Antonia Nespor was born December 10, 1889 also in Czechoslovakia⁴, daughter of Czechs **Anton Nespor** and **Aloisie Zelenka**. Antonia immigrated also in 1905⁵, settling in Manhattan, New York.

William and Antonia Prazsky had and raised three children while living in Manhattan: William (b.~1916), Otto (b.~1919), and Anna (b.~1921). William supported his family as a machinist and mechanic in a machine shop.⁵ A few years before he died he moved his family to Baychester. William died at age 45 on May 20, 1938 in Manhattan, and was buried in Saint Michaels Cemetery.⁶

Antonia and her two boys continued to live at the house in Baychester⁷. It is unknown what happened to daughter Anna.

It is not known where Antonia moved to when the house was demolished to make room for Co-Op City in the 1960s, but she stayed in the Bronx. Antonia died at age 87 in August 1976, 38 years after her husband⁸. It is not known where she is buried, but perhaps she is buried with her husband in Saint Michaels Cemetery.

There is no further information on their children.
