

RESKO-MORAN

Charles A. Resko and **Ann (Moran) Resko** lived at **2342 Boller Avenue** in Baychester, Bronx, New York in the 1950s.¹

Charles A. Resko was born on August 2, 1904 in New York², son of Hungarian emigrants **James Resko** and **Wilhelmina Lang**. He was the third of nine children.³ **Ann Moran** was born on September 10, 1902² in Ireland, parents not yet identified.

In 1940, **Ann Moran** worked as a housekeeper for a rooming house, where **Charles Resko** lived as a lodger⁴. They began 'seeing' each other, and they were married on May 7, 1949 in Bronx, New York.⁵

After marriage they moved to Baychester to **2342 Boller Avenue**. Charles worked as a chauffeur's helper for a trucking company, and Ann worked as a Labeler for a soap company.¹ As that area of Boller Avenue was taken over by Co-Op City, they lost their home. Their last residence was in the West Bronx section of the Bronx, near Yankee Stadium and Bronx Zoo.

Ann Resko died in February 1979 at age 76 in the Bronx, New York. **Charles Resko** died two years later in November 1981 at age 77 in the Bronx, New York. It is not known where they might be buried.²
