

# ROSENBLATT

**Louis Rosenblatt** (1880-??) and **Catherine (---) Rosenblatt** (1894-??) rented house at **2075 Bassett Avenue** in Baychester, Bronx, New York in the 1930s. Catherine's maiden name is unknown.

**Louis Rosenblatt** was born in New York, the son of immigrants from France. As a single man he joined the military service. In 1900<sup>1</sup> he was a private, serving in the Philippines. By 1910<sup>2</sup> he was at Plattsburgh Barracks in Clinton, New York. The next time he is found is in the 1930 census<sup>3</sup>, where he is married to Catherine. They married in 1921.

Catherine was born in Pennsylvania, daughter of Irish parents.

Louis worked as a Stationary Fireman for about 20 years. A stationary fireman fires and maintains high and low pressure boilers found in heating and ventilation systems, water treatment systems, and pumping stations.

By 1935 Louis has moved back into Manhattan. By 1940 he has a new wife, **Emily** (maiden name unknown). Emily was born in Connecticut around 1901. In 1940 he and Emily are renting at 11 West 103<sup>rd</sup> Street in Manhattan.<sup>4</sup>

No additional information on Louis, Catherine or Emily has been confirmed.
