ROTH-COONEY

Edward Roth and **Catherine (Cooney) Roth** lived for a short while in Baychester, Bronx, New York at **2354 Hunter Avenue**. In 1940 their children were grown and moved away, but they had a grandson living with them. Edward supported his family as a laborer in road construction.

Edward Roth was born around 1881 in New York City, New York, son of German immigrants. Around 1905 Edward married **Catherine Cooney**, born in 1882 in Ireland, daughter of Irish parents **John Cooney** and **Bridget Mills**¹. Catherine immigrated to New York between 1895-1900.

Edward and Catherine lived in the Bronx their adult lives, Edward working mostly as a truck driver. Catherine worked as a building janitor.² They raised two children, **John Roth** (b. 1907) and **Anna Roth** (b. 1915)³. Between 1930-1940 Edward and Catherine moved into Baychester⁴. Unfortunately, at age 59, Catherine died on September 1, 1940. She was buried in Saint Raymonds Cemetery, Bronx, New York¹. After her death, nothing further was found on Edward Roth. It is unknown when he died or where he might be buried.

No additional information has been confirmed for their two children, John and Anna. Also, it was not discovered who the parents were of the grandson, **Thomas Cauldwell**, who lived with them in 1940, and no additional information was confirmed for him. With eight years between the births of John and Anna, and Anna being too young to be Thomas' mother, it is possible that there is another unknown child that was born to Edward and Catherine Roth.
