## **RUGGIERO-LEAHON**

**Salvatore V. Ruggiero** and **Marion E. (Leahon) Ruggiero** lived in Baychester, Bronx, New York at **2231 Boller Avenue**.<sup>1</sup>

**Salvatore Ruggiero** was born on June 10, 1907 in The Bronx, New York City, New York, son of Italian immigrants **Leo Ruggiero** and **Anna Lamberti**. He grew up on Barnes Avenue, in the Olinville section of The Bronx. He left his family home when he married Marion Leahon in New Rochelle, Westchester County, NY on Mar 14, 1934.

**Marion E. Leahon** was born on June 21, 1913 in New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York, daughter of **Peter H. Leahon** and **Margaret Reynolds**. Her living in New Rochelle at the time of her marriage to Salvatore Ruggiero makes sense that the marriage took place in New Rochelle.

After marriage, Salvatore and Marion rented a large house in Baychester at 2231 Boller Avenue. There they raised two daughters, **Barbara Ann Ruggiero** and **Dolores Frances Ruggiero**. In addition to his immediate family of four, Salvatore's father-in-law **Peter Leahon** and brother-in-law **John Leahon** lived with them in 1940.<sup>5</sup>

Salvatore supported his family as a machinist and tool maker. His father-in-law Peter was an auto mechanic at a gas station.

Both daughters married in 1952 and left the family home. Sometime after that Salvatore and Marion moved to Florida.
