## **RUTTER-STEHNO**

**John William Rutter** and **Mary Elisabeth (Stehno) Rutter** lived in Baychester from the 1920's through the 1940's, and perhaps later, in a large house at **2024 Stillwell Avenue**, at the corner of DeReimer Avenue. This house is still there in 2021.

**John William Rutter** was born on May 16, 1889 in West Drayton, Middlesex, England, a suburb of London. He was the second of twelve children born to English citizens **George William Rutter** and **Bridget Mary Fitzgerald**. 1

At the young age of 20 John emigrated from England and arrived at New York in 1909, meeting his uncle **M. Fitzgerald**, who was then living in Manhattan, New York.<sup>2</sup> John immigrated with skills as a laborer. He courted and then married **Mary Elisabeth Stehno** in Manhattan on October 25, 1911.<sup>3</sup>

**Mary Elisabeth Stehno** was born either August 1890<sup>4</sup> or October 22, 1890<sup>5</sup> in Bohemia, Austria. She was the first of nine children born to **Anton Stehno** and **Vincenta Goehn**, both Bohemia, Austria citizens.<sup>6</sup> She immigrated to New York in 1896 as a six-year-old child, and lived in Manhattan, New York.

By 1913 the couple was settled in a home at 2087 Amsterdam Avenue in Manhattan, when John made his Declaration of Intention<sup>7</sup> to become an American citizen. Their first child,

## **RUTTER-STEHNO**

**Elizabeth Louise Rutter**, was born in 1912; their second child, **Lillian Rutter**, was born in 1915. The family was still living in Manhattan, and John supported his family as an IRT subway motorman.

In 1917 John and his family lived in a houseboat at 219<sup>th</sup> Street and Harlem River.<sup>8</sup> Wish I knew more about that experience. In 1919 John was granted USA citizenship. Between 1920-1930 John purchased a new home at 2024 Stillwell Avenue, in Baychester, Bronx, New York and moved his family in.<sup>9</sup>

Mary Elisabeth (Stehno) Rutter died in 1967 and was buried at Saint Mary's Cemetery, Yonkers, New York. 10 John William Rutter died two years later in 1969. It is not known where he might be buried. 11
