Anthony Savarese and his wife Ella Reed owned a house in Baychester in 1940 at 2301 Hunter Avenue.¹ Prior to marriage, Anthony lived in two other locations in Baychester: in 1910 he lived on Baychester Avenue (no number back then)²; in 1920 he lived at Baychester Avenue³ and 2223 Wright Avenue⁴— two addresses because there were two 1920 enumerations, but they were at corners to each other.

Anthony was born around 1877 in Egypt, son of Egypt native **Raffael Savarese** and Italian native **Rosa Buttel**. His immigration and naturalization dates are conflicted in the two 1920 census records, and actual immigration papers were not found.

Anthony Savarese and Ella Reed were married on January 7, 1906 in Manhattan, New York. Ella was born about 1886 in Long Island, New York, daughter of Pennsylvania native James Reed and German immigrant Minna Walter. Ella grew up in Brooklyn. Where they went to live immediately after marriage is unknown. They had six children between 1907 and 1923. Anthony supported his family as a Bridge Tender. It is possible that he worked on the railway bridge that bordered the neighborhood and was over Givens Creek.

After 1940 nothing has been located about Anthony and Ella. It is not known when they died or where they might be buried.

Theresa Augusta Savarese was born on January 13, 1907 in Manhattan, New York. She First married **Ignatius Kearney** in 1928, living at **2202 Palmer Avenue**; and second married **Karl Laub** in 1947, living at **2232 Boller Avenue**. See biography KEARNEY-SAVARESE-LAUB.

Louis Frederick Savarese was born around 1909 in Manhattan, New York. He married **Dorothy E. Krafft** on October 12, 1930 in Manhattan, New York. In 1940 they were living at **2221 Boller Avenue**, one block from Louis' parents. See biography SAVARESE-KRAFFT.

Rose Savarese was born about 1912 in Manhattan, New York. She grew up in Baychester. Rose married **Frank McCarthy** (b. 1913), and by 1940 the couple was living in another house in Baychester at **2301 Boller Avenue**, one block from Rose's parents. Frank supported them as a New York City fireman. Nothing else is known about this couple.

Ralph Savarese was born on October 6, 1913 in New York. He and his wife **Grace Krueger** were living at **2319 Boller Avenue** in Baychester after their marriage. See biography SAVARESE-KRUEGER.

Francis Savarese was born about 1919 in New York. He lived with his parents through 1940, and worked as an electrical appliance worker in an electric shop. Through 1940 he remained single. Nothing else is known about him.

Joseph Savarese was born about 1924 in New York. He lived with his parents through 1940 in Baychester. He married a woman named **Margaret** (maiden name unknown) about 1950. He

SAVARESE-REED

was a well-known horse racing jockey. ¹¹ Joseph and Margaret had one daughter. Joseph died in Fort Pierce, St. Lucie, Florida on January 9, 2009. ¹² He was cremated; remains unknown. His wife Margaret outlived him after 59 years of marriage. Nothing further is known about Margaret.
