

In 1940 **Frank and Marie Schnabl** lived in Baychester at **2324 Boller Avenue**, in a house owned by Frank Schnabl.

Frank Schnabl was born on December 30, 1894 in Austria, son of **Franz Schnabl** of Austria. He met and married his first wife **Marie** (maiden name unknown) in Austria, around 1920, and they had a daughter, **Hilda Schnabl**, born in Vienna in 1922. In 1923 Frank immigrated to America¹, leaving his wife and daughter behind. He joined his uncle in Union, New Jersey. By the time his wife Marie and daughter Hilda immigrated to America in 1928 he was living in Manhattan, New York. Marie and Hilda joined him there.²

Frank's first wife Marie died before 1940. **Frank Schnabl** married again, this time to **Marie Hlawitschka**, on August 12, 1940. **Marie Hlawitschka** was born on July 29, 1897 in Vienna, Austria, daughter of **Anton Hlawitschka** and **Emma Reinelt**.

By 1940, Frank purchased the house at **2324 Boller Avenue** in Baychester and moved there with his second wife. His daughter **Hilda Schnabl** was not accounted for in the 1940 census, so her whereabouts is unknown. He supported his family by working as a machinist in a paper factory.³

He registered for the 1942 WW II draft as required; he and his wife were still living at 2324 Boller Avenue at that time.⁴ Frank and Marie both took the Oath of Allegiance in 1946. In her 1941 Declaration of Intent Marie (Hlawitschka) Schnabl states she had no children.⁵

No additional information on this family has been found. There is no record of when or where they died or where they might be buried.
