

TOKER-ROMAN

George Edward Toker and his wife **Josephine A. (Roman) Toker** lived at **2222 Boller Avenue** in Baychester, Bronx, New York.¹

George E. Toker was born in Stamford, Fairfield, Connecticut on March 25, 1897, son of **George Toker**.² **Josephine A. Roman** was born in Connecticut about 1899¹, daughter of Austrian immigrants **Michael and Sussanna Roman**³. **George E. Toker** married **Josephine A. Roman** in Stamford, CT on June 25, 1920.⁴ Together they lived in Stamford until the mid 1930s, when they moved to the Bronx, New York.

By 1950 **George and Josephine Toker** were living in Baychester with their son **George Toker**, daughter **Lorraine (Toker) Pellegrine**, and granddaughter **Josephine Pellegrine**. They shared a multi-family house with their daughter **Mildred (Toker) Noble** and her family (see obituary Noble-Toker).¹

George Edward Toker died in Fort Myers, Lee County, Florida in March 1967⁵. It is not known where he might be buried. No additional information has been found on his wife Josephine Toker.
