Joseph Trumm and his wife Dorothy Lambert (Henderson) Trumm live in Baychester at 2201 Palmer Avenue during the 1930s.¹ Joseph's brother Anton Trumm also lived in Baychester at 2307 Hunter Avenue (see biography TRUMM-VAN KUIJK).

Joseph Trumm was born in Holland around 1902, son of Johan Jacob Trumm and Maria Francisca Bols, both Holland natives. Dorothy Lambert Henderson was born on January 4, 1908 in the Bronx, New York, daughter of Arthur Stuart Henderson and Magdalena Mauderer² (see biography HENDERSON-MAUDERER).

Joseph and Dorothy married around 1927 and had a daughter, Dorothy. By 1930 the family had moved into Baychester at 2201 Palmer Avenue. Joseph supported his family as a Baker. By 1938 Joseph moved his family out of Baychester to Yonkers, Westchester County, New York.

It is unknown when or where Joseph Trumm or his wife Dorothy Trumm died or may be buried.

Their daughter Dorothy married in 1955. No additional information is available on her.
