

WEINLEIN-SWOBODA

John Weinlein was born on November 22, 1898¹ two days before Thanksgiving in Manhattan, New York. He was the sixth of seven children born to parents **Joseph A. Weinlein**, from Germany, and **Katherine Staab** of New York City. (See biography Weinlein-Staab.) In 1925, while living with his parents and siblings, he lived in Baychester at **2314 Boller Avenue**.

Frances Swoboda was born about 1901 in New York City, New York, the sixth of eight children born to parents **William Swoboda** and **Emma Richter**, both from Bohemia, Austria. Frances was raised in The Bronx, New York.

John Weinlein and **Frances Swoboda** married on August 13, 1925 in The Bronx, New York. They had three children: daughter Francis (born ~1927), son John (born 1928-1988) and son William (born ~1934). After marriage John and Frances were living at 2860 Buhre Avenue, Bronx, NY², which is about 1-1/2 miles from his mother's house in Baychester (2314 Boller Avenue). He was working as a truck driver. By 1940 he moved back into Baychester at **2232 Boller Avenue**,³ across the street and down the block from his mother and several siblings. He was then supporting his wife and three children working as a taxi driver.

Nothing is known of John or Frances after 1940.

THEIR CHILDREN:

Frances Weinlein married **Mr. Schumacher** and they lived in Baychester, where they had three children: Henry, Linda, and William. No additional information is known about them.

John C. Weinlein married **Gisela E. "Gee"** (maiden name unknown). John was born on Dec. 8, 1927 in The Bronx, and died on May 15, 1988. His wife Gisela was born on June 7, 1929 and died on April 28, 1995 in The Bronx. They had two children: John and Michael, and lived at **2320 Boller Avenue**. It is not known where they might be buried.

William Weinlein was born about 1934. No additional information is known about him after 1940.
